Waivers - How and when to use.

Little League Residency Waiver Request Form:

This form is for a <u>request</u> to play in another league in which the player doesn't live. This form needs to be signed by both effected leagues. The parent or guardian needs to complete the form and have it notarized. The parent or guardian must also include a letter explaining the situation. The paperwork will be turned over to the DA. The DA may also write a letter either in support or not. All paperwork will be forward to Central Region where it will be reviewed and put before the Charter Committee. The Charter Committee will rule on it and will lay out any conditions.

Little League Waiver Regulation II(d):

This form is for a player that lived and played in a league but moved out of the league and wishes to continue to play in that league. This form also applies to a player that played in the league while attending a school building in the league and now the player attends a different school building outside the league's boundaries but wishes to continue to play in the league. This form also applies to a sibling of a player already covered by this form. Documentation of address and registration is required. The DA is the final approval for this form. This is a lifetime waiver. However, if a player skips a season this form is no longer valid and can't be reinstated.

Little League Waiver Regulation IV(h):

This form is for a volunteer that has served a league as a manager/coach or board member for 2 years, that has moved or that lives outside the league's boundaries and wishes to have their sons or daughters play in that league. Documentation of a volunteer app is required. The DA is the final approval for this form. This is a lifetime waiver. However, if a player skips a season this form is no longer valid and can't be reinstated.

Little League Waiver School Enrollment Form:

This form is for a player that wants to play in a league that their school building is located in. The form must be completed and signed by a School Administrator.

These forms must be kept on file by the league. These forms must be part of a player's All Star paperwork.
